Are you able to support young people to work towards their employment, training and skills goals, on a 1:1 basis and/or in group settings? Can you motivate and encourage young people to reach their potential?

## What you will be doing

- Supporting service users aged 16+ to identify and work towards their goals relating to employment, training and skills, both one-to-one and in group settings.
- Carrying out internet and phone research about employment, training and skills opportunities which are relevant to service user.
- Encouraging service users to enrol on relevant courses to gain further skills and reach their goals, such as ESOL, Maths, English, First Aid or Food Safety.
- Supporting service users to produce up-to-date CVs, supporting statements and covering letters tailored for each application.
- Providing job search support, guiding service users to register on appropriate jobs boards and ensuring their digital profiles are up-to-date, professional and visible to employers.
- Supporting service users to use public transport and attend appointments.
- Preparing service users for job interviews, which might include discussing possible interview questions and conducting mock interviews.
- Keeping in regular contact with service users to check on their progress towards meeting their goals.
- Identifying barriers to engagement and helping them overcome any challenges by putting realistic targets in place to help them achieve their goals.
- Recording contacts with each service user and reporting back to the service.
- Adhering to Barnardo's policies and procedures at all times, including Barnardo's: Safeguarding; Equality, Diversity and Inclusion; Health & Safety; Data Protection; Confidentiality; Recording policies and procedures.
- Participating fully in training and supervision.
- Volunteering within Barnardo's Values and Behaviours.

- Reliable, punctual and trustworthy.
- Approachable and welcoming.
- Excellent listening, verbal and written communication skills.
- An understanding of the skills needed to gain employment, such as job searching, completing job applications and job interview skills.
- IT Literate and the ability to use the internet.
- Being passionate about making a difference to the lives of vulnerable community members.
- Being non-judgmental and positive in their attitude to working with individuals from different backgrounds.
- An understanding of diverse communities and the related barriers to accessing employment and training opportunities.
